"Support Randy Fleming" Rally

Earlier today we met with Sgt. Phil Carter at the OPP Cayuga station to outline the details of a rally to show support for Randy Fleming after the OPP illegally arrested him for carrying a Canadian Flag as he walked down Argyle St. in Caledonia. In support, we are organizing a rally to have people take the same route as Mr. Fleming did when the OPP stopped him. We will March down Argyle St. carrying Canadian Flags past DCE.

At no time will we attempt to raise a Canadian Flag or attempt to enter DCE. Our goal is simply to show support for Randy Fleming in demonstrating that all Canadians have the right to walk down any road carrying a Canadian Flag. Once the March is done we will then rally at the Cayuga Police Station at approx. 2:30 for a few speeches and the hanging of two posters on hydro poles. The posters are of the photo showing the excessive force used against Mr. Fleming during his illegal arrest. The approx. end of this event is 3:30.

Sgt. Carter has informed us that the OPP has consented to this protest. They accepted all the details of this rally. The OPP will allow us to march down Argyle St. with Canadian Flags past DCE in Caledonia.
