
WARRANT OF ARREST

TO ALL POLICE OFFICERS in Ontario

AND TO THE OFFICERS OF all Correctional Institutes in Ontario

WHEREAS I have found that Dawn Smith, Janie Jamieson and unknown persons identified in the application as John Doe and Jane Doe, being persons present at the barricades and blocking access to Douglas Creek Estates as described in Schedule "A" attached to this warrant are in civil and criminal contempt of the Order of the Honourable


Mr. Justice B. Matheson dated March 3, 2006 and have ordered that the said persons are hereby sentenced as follows:

- a) THIS COURT SUSPENDS the passing of sentence and directs that the Respondents be released on the conditions prescribed in a probation order for a term not exceeding six months, pursuant to s. 731(1) of the *Criminal Code*.
- b) THIS COURT FURTHER ORDER THAT THE CONDITIONS OF THE PROBATION ORDER shall include the compulsory conditions contained in s. 732.1(2) of the *Criminal Code*.
- c) THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS THAT THE CONDITIONS OF THE PROBATION ORDER shall include the following optional conditions, pursuant to s. 731.1 of the *Criminal Code*:
 - (i) Accompany the police to be fingerprinted and photographed.
 - (ii) Not attend within 100 feet of the Douglas Creek Estate site except for the purpose of normal travel on ~~Hwy 6~~ Argyle St 

YOU ARE ORDERED TO ARREST Dawn Smith and Janie Jamieson and unknown persons identified in the Application as John Doe and Jane Doe, being persons present at the barricades and blocking access to Douglas Creek Estates, as described in Schedule "A" attached to this warrant in contravention of the Order of Mr. Justice Matheson dated March 3, 2006 and fingerprint and photograph them. Once they have been fingerprinted and photographed they are to be released from custody. Upon release, each person is to be

- a) provided with a copy of the probation order referred to above,
- b) provided with an explanation of the substance of subsections 732.2(3) and (5) and section 733.1 of the *Criminal Code*, and
- c) provided with an explanation of the procedure for applying under subsection 732.2(3) for a change to the optional conditions.

YOU ARE FURTHER ORDERED to take reasonable measures to ensure that the offenders understand the order and the explanations given to offenders as set out above.
