Council Denounces Weekend Disturbance in Caledonia

On Saturday December 1st, a confrontation broke out between protestors and those present at a smoke shop at the south end of Argyle Street.

Haldimand County Council stands united in denouncing the actions of any individuals involved in the disturbance Saturday. Council is committed to reaching a peaceful resolution to land claim issues in co-operation with the Federal and Provincial Governments.

These random actions by a few individuals negatively impact the day-to-day lives of residents, local business and the ongoing land claim negotiation process while the social and economic impact on the community can never be undone.

Haldimand Council and staff on behalf of residents will continue to pressure the Federal and Provincial Governments towards resolving land claims, removing the smoke shop at the south end of Argyle Street and investing in our revitalization plans to support vibrant and sustainable communities.
