## **MCGUINTY TALK LEADS TO NO ACTION...AGAIN**

*Liberals promise to establish buffer zone in Caledonia then fail to act, again*

(Toronto, ON) – The McGuinty Liberals should get to work and establish the buffer zone that they promised at the negotiating table in Caledonia, Progressive Conservative Party Leader John Tory said today.

“This is just more of the same inaction and weak leadership that we have seen from Dalton McGuinty throughout this dispute,” said Tory. “It’s typical that the McGuinty Liberals would announce something with fanfare, pretending that they are actually doing something and then not deliver.”

Tory made his comments today after Haldiman Mayor Marie Trainor expressed her frustration and disappointment that the McGuinty Liberals had still not acted on their commitment to establish a buffer zone in between the disputed land and the rest of Caledonia. The dispute has been going on now for 221 days.

Tory added: “This is the McGuinty way, it’s how they’ve handled the entire situation in Caledonia, no action and no respect for the rule of law.”
