

'Political Prisoner': OPP Involvement

Albert Douglas appeared in court on Jan. 9, 2008 and proclaimed himself to be a 'Political Prisoner' and not a criminal to which his supporters in court applauded and shouted, "Way to go, Al".

Mr. Douglas appears to believe that his violent actions are a form of political speech. Let's review Mr. Douglas' political views for a moment.

Mr. Douglas believes he has the political right to assault and rob people – i.e. the charge of assault and robbery of the CHCH TV cameramen.

Mr. Douglas believes he has the political right to kill people – i.e. the charge of attempted murder against an OPP officer on June 9, 2006.

Mr. Douglas believes he has the political right to hijack vehicles and to forcibly confine people – i.e. charges from June 9, 2006.

Can anyone imagine what would happen if all Canadians shared this type of political expression? Can you imagine every single person in Canada starting to believe that violence is an acceptable form of political expression? What would happen if people believed that such violence is protected under the Canadian Charter of Rights, as many of the Native Protesters claim?

Are you pissed off over the GST... try killing someone. Are you upset by the slow pace of Government to address an issue.... try assaulting and robbing your neighbour.

The only difference I can see between the political expression the Native Protesters believe they have the right to and the examples I just gave is the Native Protesters have the Ontario Provincial Police aiding and abetting them.

If you are angry over the fact that the Liberal party repeatedly promised to get rid of the GST in 1992 and decide to express your political view by assaulting people you can be sure the police will be right there to arrest you.

However, if you are a Native person and understand that Violence equals MORE Money and decide one day to encourage McGuinty and Harper to come up with more Millions by hospitalizing Sam Gaultieri or someone else then you can be assured that the OPP will stand by and provide cover while you commit your criminal act.

You can be absolutely assured that the OPP will provide a police line facing residents to ensure that your criminal behaviour can proceed without any interference. You can be 100% assured that NO OPP officer will take any steps to arrest any Native person during the commission of the crime and be assured you can escape from the crime scene without any impediment by the OPP. Finally, you can be absolutely assured that unless the crime appears on TV you will not be arrested.

In fact, I believe Mr. FANTINO should be arrested for aiding and abetting criminal behaviour that he knew or should have known would occur due directly to his repeated public statements that Native Protesters are heroes while making non-Natives out to be evil troublemakers.

Crimes occur in every city and town across Canada by members within all sorts of groups. The ONLY difference in Caledonia is one group has been convinced that violence is acceptable and the OPP repeatedly justify that violence with their propaganda.

It takes two types of criminal behaviour for violence in Caledonia to occur... 1) Native Protesters believing they are above the law... 2) Individual OPP Officers who see getting a pay cheque is more important than coming to the aid of victims WHILE they are being assaulted.

The reason we focus on the OPP officers is quite simple... there is crime in every town and the solution is to employ a police force. In CASHedonia OPP officers leave their moral principals at home to ensure they are more than willing to stand and watch people be hospitalized.

In our view the greater crime committed is by the OPP officers... Sorry maybe they too see it as their 'political' expression to stand by and do nothing.

The Mayor accused Fantino of Treason... we know he flaunts Ontario Liabe and Slander Laws... we know he has encouraged his officers to charge residents before an investigation has even started... we know his many public statements encourage Native Protesters to use violence against residents... we know Fantino is in direct communication with the very people who commit the violence in Caledonia. If McGuinty wasn't protecting Fantino he would have been fired months ago.

I have yet to hear anyone explain to what limit OPP officers are willing to go in order to allow crimes to happen by just standing and watching crimes being committed. OPP officers stood by and watched a fellow officer almost be murdered without taking action... if they will not help their own then they cannot be trusted to protect anyone even if it means someone may die.
