

Harper has Confirmed: Two Tier Justice is now Nation Wide

For over a year we have been exposing the fact that the OPP has forced upon the residents in Caledonia a Two Tier Justice system. This is a proven fact.

The first to declare there was Two Tier Justice in Caledonia was OPP Association President Karl Walsh who told the media in June 2006 that the OPP were forcing their officers to follow a Two Tier Justice system. Since Mr. Walsh informed the public of this serious problem within the OPP, we have heard the local Mayor, local councilor, local MPP and numerous residents tell the media that the OPP has forced upon them a Two Tier Justice system.

What is Two Tier Justice?

Quite simply it is when an OPP officer witnesses a crime taking place and once he identifies the person committing the crime is a Native person then he is ordered to stand down and take no action to prevent the crime. Of course if the OPP officer witnesses a non-native committing a crime the officer immediately steps in and arrests the person committing the crime.

What types of crimes have the OPP been willing to stand by and watch? Attacks on seniors, attacks on camera crews, attacks upon US border guards, attempted murder of OPP officers, digging up the highway, numerous fires, destruction of power station, destruction of vehicles, etc.

We are told that in our Multicultural society that all people are equal under the law. That all groups are free from Racial Profiling, free from Racial discrimination and that all people have certain fundamental rights as guaranteed by the Constitution as described in the Charter of Rights and Freedoms.

Canada has only had a Constitution since 1980 and there is no way for average citizens to enforce their rights if Governments and police forces choose to systematically violate their rights.

Unlike the USA, Canada does not have any laws against violation of someone's Civil Rights. Therefore, unless you are wealthy and have a lot of time you will never be able to enforce your rights.

This is because under a British system it is believed that Governments would do the right thing and enforce the Constitution.

Can you imagine if a police force was to suddenly arrest every Black person driving down the 401 simply because they were Black? The politicians would step in immediately and fire any police chief or commissioner who would dare to violate the Civil Rights of Black people.

But what happens in Canada when, for decades, politicians have been made to feel guilty for their own failure to deal with native issues? What happens when a minority group sees the lack of political will to enforce laws and takes advantage of this weakness? What happens when time after time the system turns a blind eye to serious criminal acts by one group against the rest of Canada?

We get to where we are now.

The Harper Government claims to believe in the 'Rule of Law'. They claim to be a Law & Order Government. But what we have seen are two major issues that have been exposed because of the Day of Action.

First, the Constitution of this country is meaningless – written on paper and enforced by no one.

Second, that the direct threat of violence and terrorist acts against Canadian citizens (backed up with serious crimes already committed) will result in billions of dollars being paid out to the blackmailers along with land be handed over.

What makes this even worse is that the vast majority of Native people are peace loving people who want what all Canadians want. But the Government is repeatedly demonstrating to all Canadians that violence is rewarded while peaceful protests go unheard.

For every person in Canada who is watching there is a clear message – you want money, you want the Government to listen then use violence and crime to force your views upon the Canadian public.

What we have in Canada, thanks to Harper, is a Nation Wide Two Tier Justice system.

There is no way the Government would allow me or any other group to publicly call upon people to pick up guns and attack the economic systems of this country. There is no way any one of us would be allowed to threaten the lives of the Canadian public and police officers.

No non-Native has any rights as of this moment. All rights are now subject to the conditional approval of Native protesters. The right to travel across this country is now subject to the radical native protesters. The right to personal security is also subject to whether police are willing to act to prevent harm against individuals.

People in Caledonia have witnessed the OPP stand by while their homes are attacked. They have seen the OPP stand by for hours while Native protesters do nightly intimidation with fires and loud noise. Insurance companies have refused to pay for damage to homes because they claim what is happening is an insurrection. Some mortgage companies will not give mortgages out in Caledonia.

What is the average person to do when the police refuse to uphold the laws of Canada and when politicians are unwilling to rebuke the police for their failure? What do people do when Governments at all levels pay out to the blackmail?

This is where the problem really starts because once everyone on both sides is frustrated then both sides will choose violence because Governments and Police refuse to fulfill their duty in a democratic society.

Instead, I would suggest that people get active. Not just for June 29th but from here on. Join us to hold the police and Government accountable. End all this B.S. by our politicians who say they believe in Law & Order while paying out billions to the blackmailers.
