

Fantino Rants and Threatens Council & Mr. Grice

Last night Mr. Fantino went on a Rant and sent an email to Council, to several OPP officers and to the Ontario Government.

It now appears that Mr. Fantino is becoming increasingly concerned that Council is about to take a more pro-active role in exposing OPP Two Tier Justice. On Sunday April 1 at the Town Hall Meeting the council members who were present supported the idea of a rolling blockade to Queen's Park.

Also, in the same meeting, the residents made it clear that Council had to stop working against "outsiders". A few days later I shut down my site to apply more pressure to Council.

Well, Fantino appears to have blown a gasket. He told council that they would be held responsible if Gary McHale did any more rallies in Caledonia. He singled out Mr. Grice to be responsible for any violence, any demands or any harm done during Gary McHale's rallies.

Mr. Fantino went as far as to state that he would encourage individual officers to sue the Council, Mr. Grice and Gary McHale.

The council was then informed that Mr. Fantino was recommending that the OPP contract not be renewed. He sent this recommendation to the Ontario Government.

This is Pure Intimidation by Fantino

It is clear that Mr. Fantino is attempting to pressure our political leaders into not supporting what the People have asked Council to support.

We are not a police state, but slowly we have seen Mr. Fantino actively take steps to stop people's Charter of Rights in Caledonia. Mr. Fantino knows full well that the Supreme Court has ruled on whether or not we can place items on hydro poles but it doesn't stop him from sending out hundreds of officers to stop us from putting up Canadian Flags.

While Mr. Fantino has been Commissioner, individuals have been slandered, people have illegally been kept in jail, secret cameras have been placed in a home and now there is the attempt to pressure politicians into remaining quiet.
