Dear Mr. McHale:

I am writing in response to your letter of September 8, 2006 to the Premier, the Attorney General and myself regarding your proposed rally on October 15, 2006.

I would urge you to consider public safety issues arising from a rally in Caledonia. Ontario, Canada, Haldimand County and the Haudenosaunee/Six Nations, are concerned that a rally in Caledonia at this time could pose a threat to public safety.

Ontario has been working diligently to resolve the issues in Caledonia and to create a secure environment for those people living in close proximity to the Douglas Creek Estate lands. The government recognizes the public's right to engage in peaceful protests, however that right must be balanced against the need for public safety.

I have enclosed a response to your letter of September 8, 2006 from the Ontario Realty Corporation which administers the Douglas Creek Estate lands on behalf of Ontario.


I have been asked to respond to your letter of September 8, 2006, to the Premier, the Attorney General and the Minister Responsible for Aboriginal Affairs, regarding the proposed rally on October 15, 2006.

In your letter, you requested access to the Douglas Creek Estates (DCE ) lands located in Caledonia for the purposes of the rally.

The Ontario Realty Corporation administers the DCE lands on behalf of the Province of Ontario. In response to your original enquiry and in keeping with its established practices, the Ontario Realty Corporation does not consent to your use of or entry upon the DCE lands as these lands are not open to the public where entry could create a safety risk and the proposed use is incompatible with the current state of the property itself.

If you intend to continue with this rally, I recommend that you contact the municipality regarding any permitting or other requirements it may have.

Dear Mr. Dadd:

Thank you for your letter dated Oct. 4<sup>th</sup>, 2006.

In this letter we did not have your consent to use or enter DCE lands as it is not "open to the public where entry could create a safety risk and the proposed use is incompatible with the current state of the property itself."

I would fully agree with such a statement. Therefore, can you answer why then does your corporation continue to allow people on this very same land who have committed and continue to commit criminal offenses against the people of Caledonia? Just in the last few days there have been illegal activities on these grounds.

Can I remind you that the local school has built a fence, installed security cameras and has OPP officers in the playground each day to protect the children from the people you have allowed to use this land.

Are you aware that one complete home, which is under your control, has been taken down and the material stolen by the people you have okayed to be on the land. As I type this letter they are taking down a second home.

Since you are well aware of these details then why have you allowed their presence on land that you control? Am I to understand that you and your corporation are legally taking responsibility for future criminal acts that occur by the people you have allowed on this land? You have been made aware of these activities by the media and you continue to allow the residents of Caledonia to be intimidated by the occupiers.

Furthermore, as of this date the number of criminal acts committed by the March for Freedom is zero and the amount of property damage caused by us is also zero. We cannot say the same for the people you continue to allow on this land.

On what basis, therefore, do you decide that a group, with a known criminal history and of property damage both to taxpayers' property and local residents' homes, can use this land but we who have done no harm to person or property cannot?

Finally, can you inform me at what point will your corporation decide to not allow these current occupiers access to this land? Just how much more property damage is acceptable to you? How many more people must be assaulted before your corporation will tell them they cannot use this land? Why did you not tell them to stop using the land because of the attack on the power station, the burning down of the bridge, the destruction of cars, the attack upon seniors, the attempted murder of a police officer and the continued harassment of the people of Caledonia?

I look forward to hearing from you why such criminal acts are permitted by those you have authorized to use the DCE land but we, who have committed no crimes, are not allowed to use the land.

I ask that you review the above points and contact me A.S.A.P. regarding my request for use of the DCE land.
