

DCE Occupation was motivated by Racism

Toronto Life – Aug 2007: For Jamieson, the story raised a red flag. The plan projected 7,000 new residents in Haldimand County alone over the next 20 years. "That really frightened me," she recalls. "All these strangers moving right onto our doorstep, and we had no say in it."

In 1981 we moved to Toronto – Steeles and Warden Ave. to be more exact. We moved into an apartment and lived on the 20th floor. Although it was part of Scarborough, it looked like we were in the country since you had to drive on dirt roads to get to our building.

We lived there for 14 years and 200,000 people moved into the area. During the 1980s was the time when Canada opened the doors to people from Hong Kong with over 500,000 moving to Canada in a few short years.

We witnessed the malls change from English to Asian and one by one businesses started to have Asian only signs. Home after home was built and purchased by Asian people and slowly even the churches started to have Asian only services.

To us this wasn't a problem. My wife donated time teaching English as a Second Language to Asian people but many whites and blacks had a hard time. Suddenly their neighborhood had a new culture, customs and language.

Throughout history racism starts when such changes occur in communities when those who hold to their culture and customs are forced to allow others to live side by side with them.

Just how many white communities over the years hated it when the first black family moved in. To them their white culture, traditions and customs were suddenly under attack. For these whites their whole way of life had to be defended.

This is where groups like the KKK start to get their members – when one culture is unwilling to allow another to live side by side then racism and hatred starts to spread.

As I stated we didn't have any problem with multiculturalism and when we moved and bought our current home in Richmond Hill, it didn't bother us that such a large Asian community existed in Richmond Hill. In fact, there are many strip malls that are almost completely non-English. It's a great way to sample and learn of other cultures.

I have never understood racism or those who hold such views.

What has shocked me more is the outright racism by many Native Protesters against non-Natives. In fact, it has become clear that the occupation of DCE was motivated by Racism.

Janie Jamieson's statements in Toronto Life demonstrates Racism

Imagine my surprise to read that Janie Jamieson, Native Spokesperson for DCE occupation, used the very words that whites used when Blacks move in to their neighborhoods. When the Asians first moved into Scarborough they were met with the same racist statements and

attitude that Jamieson admits to in the Toronto Life story. The following is the quote from Toronto Life Aug 2007:

For Jamieson, the story raised a red flag. The plan projected 7,000 new residents in Haldimand County alone over the next 20 years. "That really frightened me," she recalls. "All these strangers moving right onto our doorstep, and we had no say in it."

This is like reading white supremacy material that shows a fear that Blacks are moving in and the whites have no say. Whites fear their culture and traditions would start to change. Their children would slowly mix and white culture would be lost.

Jamieson states in the Toronto Life story that "We have such a strong, rich history..." This is true but so does every group. What Jamieson is presenting is that by allowing Italians, Germans, Asians, Africans etc. to move right onto their 'doorstep' that she was 'frightened'.

This truly is the heart of racism.

We live in a condo and we cannot say no Blacks allowed or no Asians allowed. That is illegal and is racism. What Jamieson is clearly stating is that she 'had no say' in who was moving in.

You're damn right you have no say nor should you. No person has the right to say No Blacks allowed or Jews Not Wanted etc.

You may follow the pattern of the KKK and claim to be protecting your culture and preserve it for your children, but racism is racism regardless of who is the racist.

No Group, whether White Supremacist or Native Supremacist, has the right to say who can live where. Unfortunately our Government is more than willing to work with the Native Supremacists as a means to appeasement.

This is like paying the KKK not to victimize Black People

Janie Jamieson and the other Protesters illegally occupied a sub-division to ensure that no Blacks, no Asians, no Italians, no East Indians etc. could move onto their 'doorstep'.

They proceeded to assault police, residents and media to force their brand of racism on Canada. They then back up this violence with burning tires, a bridge, barns & sheds and destroying vehicles, blockading the highway and railway for weeks and finally destroying the power substation.

The violence against non-Natives increased to include attacking USA border guards and attempted murder of OPP officers.

As Jamieson stated in the Toronto Life story she was 'frightened' by all those 'strangers moving right onto our (her) doorstep, and we had no say in it'.

Those 'strangers' that she feared were average Canadians who wanted a place to live and raise their children. Some immigrated to Canada for a better life and some moved away from the big city to find a place where they didn't have to be afraid of crime.

What these people didn't know was that there were people, like Jamieson, who would be allowed to control where different races live. The OPP and the McGuinty Government would allow Jamieson and others to determine where different races were allowed to live.

Mixing the Cultures is Genocide

It has been repeated many times by Native Spokespeople that Canada is committing Genocide against Natives. What they mean is that Canada is changing Native Culture and they see this as Genocide.

To some of these Native Protesters the mixing of the races or the mixing of the culture is Genocide. To some Natives allowing the mixing of cultures or races will only produce an impure culture.

This sounds exactly like what White Supremacists say. Hitler's master plan was to ensure that the Aryan race didn't have mixed blood. The KKK talked about blacks & whites producing "Mongos" and the Natives use the term "Apple" which is mixing of whites and natives.

Such Racism cannot be allowed to determine the policies of the McGuinty Government and cannot be allowed to be supported by the OPP.

Currently McGuinty has purchased DCE which the OPP ensure is a haven for criminal activities. OPP ensure no resident can act to protect themselves or their property against these criminal acts and the OPP do not enter DCE to arrest any criminals.

In effect, the McGuinty Government and the OPP are aiding and abetting criminal behaviour which, as stated above, is motivated by Racism.

You can wrap it up in a Native Flag and claim to be protecting your women and children but such words are used by each Supremacist group.
